

KNOW THE Signs

- cold and clammy skin with a bluish tint (lips and fingernails)
- unresponsive, unable to be awakened as if in a deep sleep
- very small pupils
- ▶ limp and relaxed body
- choking, gurgling, snoring, or vomiting
- slow, irregular, or stopped breathing and/or heartbeat

WHAT TO DO next

- ▶ call 911 immediately
- administer NARCAN (or another overdosereversal medication) if available
- stay with the person and monitor their breathing until help arrives

Acting quickly can save a life. If the overdose occurred within Wake County and EMS administered an overdose-reversal medication, Healing Transitions' Rapid Responders will visit the person 24-72 hours after the overdose event. If someone is in need of harm reduction supplies or would like to connect with the Rapid Responder program, they can call (919) 703-6290.
